### **Emergency Medical Technician-Basic, Adv. EMT**

### **How To Apply:**

- 1. Submit an application at <a href="www.westerntc.edu/apply">www.westerntc.edu/apply</a>. Choose "Enroll in a Program" and select the Adv. EMT or EMT-Basic program which is found under the "Law, Public Safety, Corrections and Security" cluster area on the application. Choose "EMT Basic full program" or "Adv. EMT" (\$30)
- 2. Complete a background check via ViewPoint Screening (\$40)
- 3. Read, Sign and Return the following forms to admissions@westerntc.edu
  - a. Essential Functions Form
  - b. Supplemental Information Form
- 4. Complete 2Step TB Testing with your healthcare provider
- 5. Upload 2Step TB Testing results, COVID-19 vaccination proof, the COVID-19 clinical release form and all other immunizations to ViewPoint Screening Health Portal (\$20)

# **EMR to EMT Part 1, Critical Care Transport - Paramedic**

### **How To Apply:**

1. Submit an application at <a href="www.westerntc.edu/apply">www.westerntc.edu/apply</a>. Choose "Just take a course or two" and indicate you are interested in the EMR to EMT Part 1, or Critical Care Transport course.

# **Emergency Medical Technician-Basic Part 2:**

A current WI Emergency Medical Responder certification is required. This course builds upon the EMR course. Once completed, candidates will be eligible to participate in the National Registry of EMT Exam.

### **How To Apply:**

Choose "Enroll in a Program" and select the EMT-Basic program which is found under the "Law, Public Safety, Corrections and Security" cluster area on the application. Choose "Emergency Medical Technician-Part 2" (\$30)

- 3. Read, Sign and Return the following forms to admissions@westerntc.edu
  - a. Essential Functions Form
  - b. Supplemental Information Form
- 4. Complete 2Step TB Testing with your healthcare provider
- 5. Upload 2Step TB Testing results, COVID-19 vaccination proof, the COVID-19 clinical release form and all other immunizations to <u>ViewPoint Screening Health Portal</u> (\$20)
