

Dear Upcoming Graduate,

Congratulations on your graduation from Western Technical College! As such, you are eligible to participate in our spring commencement ceremony. This event will take place Saturday, April 27, at 2:00 p.m. at the La Crosse Center, 300 Harborview Plaza, La Crosse. The ceremony will be for all graduates from Fall 2023, Spring 2024, and Summer 2024, and typically lasts about two hours. **Please note that the date for graduation is one week later this year.**

You are automatically eligible based on credits completed, so there is no need to apply for graduation or register to participate in the ceremony.

Before the big day!

Western will be hosting a Graduation Fair event for students who graduated in December or intend to graduate this spring. The fair will be held on Monday, April 15 from 8:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. and Monday, April 22 from 3:00 p.m.-8:00 p.m. at the Lunda Center, 333 7th St. N., La Crosse. At this event, students will select their cap and gowns from a variety of sizes. Students at Regional Locations can request their cap and gowns at the campus' front office by April 8 for delivery to that location. The commencement packet includes your gown, cap and tassel, instructions, and six announcements. The apparel items are yours to keep!

If you require any special arrangements to participate in the ceremony, such as a ramp to get up on the stage, special seating, or any other requests, please contact Eric Jacobson at 608-785-9291 by April 24.

At the event!

Parking for people with disabilities may be found in the lower level of the parking ramp located directly across the street from the La Crosse Center on Second Street and in designated parking spaces located in neighboring parking lots. The La Crosse Center offers a passenger drop-off zone at the main entrance. Designated wheelchair and handicap accessible seating is located throughout the La Crosse Center on the concourse level of the arena.

Graduates should report to the La Crosse Center by 1:00 p.m. to line up in order by program. (Please do not bring purses or any valuables with you.) You will need to fill out a card with your name and hometown for the reader to announce as you walk across the stage.

Commencement photographs will be taken by professional photographers to record the moment you are awarded your diploma, and as you exit the stage. **You will be able to view proofs and purchase photos online.** There is no obligation to purchase. Families are encouraged to remain in their seats during the ceremony and limit picture taking to before or after the commencement ceremony. **Attendees will not be allowed on the arena floor during the ceremony.**
