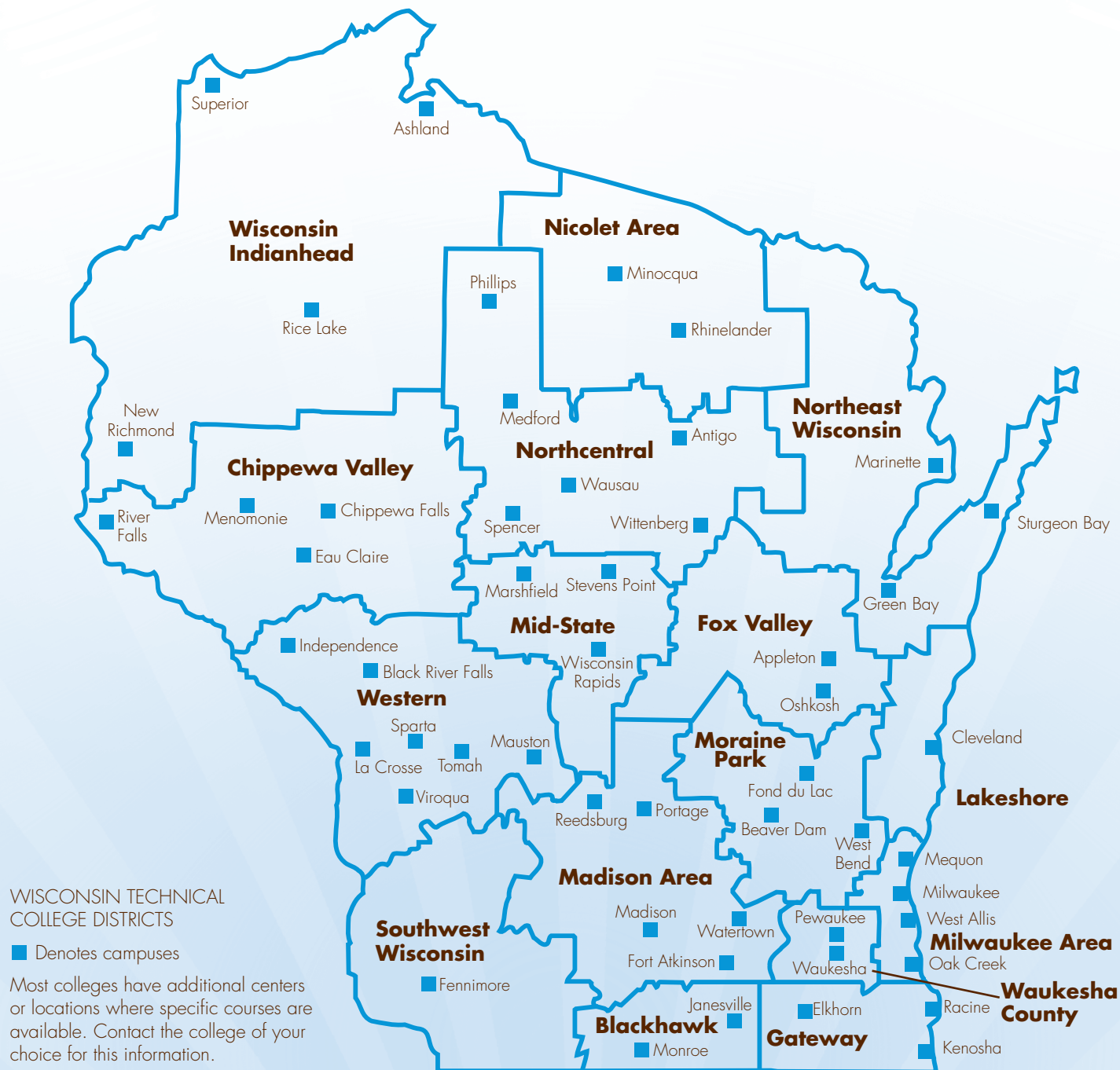

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THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE COMPASS TEST

- There is a \$20 examination fee for 2 or more portions of the test, which includes 3 subtests—Math, Reading, and Writing. As of July 1, 2009, there will be a retest fee of \$10.00 for each retesting. If you are taking the test at the La Crosse Campus this fee needs to be paid at the Cashier's office located in the Welcome Center (400 Seventh Street North). If you are taking the test at one of the outreach centers, you can pay at the front desk. It is a good idea to show up a few minutes early so that you have time to do this before your exam. If you just need to take a single portion of the test, and have not taken any other portion, there is no fee.
- You are required to present a picture ID at the time you take the test. (i.e. driver's license, school ID, or photo in a school yearbook).
- You should know your social security number but do not need to bring the card with you.
- The full series of tests will take approximately 2 hours to complete. This time will vary from person to person as the test is not timed.
- If you have current COMPASS, ACT, or ASSET scores (within 5 years) or have a post-secondary degree or college semester credits you may not need to take this test. Please consult an advisor or counselor at (608) 785-9553.
- If you have a disability and are in need of special accommodations to take the admission test, please contact Kristina Puent at (608) 785-9875 or (608) 785-9551 (V/TTY) at least one week prior to the time you would like to test.
- If you have not earned a high school diploma or equivalent (except Nursing Assistant students), please first request an appointment with one of our counselors at (608) 785-9553.
- If you would like to review your reading, writing, math or science skills prior to taking the admission test, please contact Instructional Support Services in the Academic Resource Center, Room 100, 400 Seventh Street North, La Crosse, WI or call (608) 785-9535 for class information.
- Out-of-district residents may find it more convenient to test at a technical college in their area. Call your local college directory or the Assessment Center at Western for a list of schools that administer accepted tests (608) 785-9566.

Pre-admission testing at Western Technical College is done by appointment at 6 different locations. Please contact the Regional Learning Center nearest you to schedule an appointment. If you have general questions, please contact the Assessment Center at the La Crosse campus (608) 785-9566 or 800-322-9982 and ask for the Assessment Center.
