MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

**WISCONSIN TECHNICAL COLLEGE SYSTEM
AND
LAKELAND UNIVERSITY**

RN TO BSN COMPLETION PROGRAM

The purpose of this document is to establish a cooperative relationship between Lakeland University (LU) and the sixteen (16) schools in the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) to provide a Baccalaureate degree opportunity to students that are completing an Associate Degree in Applied Science in Nursing and wishing to enroll in LU's RN to BSN Completion Program. This partnership will assist in better serving the needs of associate degree students with personalized admissions and academic advising services throughout the student's lifecycle.

WHEREAS, in consideration of this partnership, the WTCS schools will allow LU to provide students with information about LU's RN to BSN Completion Program through mutually agreed upon channels of communication; and,

THEREFORE, LU recognizes that a partnership with WTCS schools will provide students enrolled in the agreed upon program a tuition-free course.

FURTHER, LET IT BE RESOLVED, LU will provide a consortium scholarship to students in the WTCS Nursing program. The scholarship will be equal to a 20% discount for the remainder of the student's Baccalaureate studies at LU, guaranteed admission following graduation, start as a junior, free application, and support from LU advisors.

This partnership is effective November 29, 2023, and will continue until either party requests the dissolution of said partnership in writing and signed by the authorized representative.

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The parties of this agreement, WTCS and the Lakeland University RN to BSN Completion Program, hereby agree to the following terms and conditions:

- **Admission:**
 - Successful completion of the Associate of Applied Science – Nursing at a WTCS college with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or above.
 - An active, unencumbered RN license is required prior to enrolling in the RN to BSN practicum course.
- **Early Admission:** Students enrolled in the final terms of an associate degree nursing program may be approved for early admission to Lakeland University and eligible to enroll in select RN to BSN Completion Program coursework.
- **Transferring as an Associate Degree Graduate:** Associate degree nursing graduates from the WTCS are eligible to transfer up to 90 credits (semester hours) that will be applied toward a Lakeland University Bachelor of Science (BSN) degree (see transfer guide below). Individual evaluation of WTCS nursing graduates' transcripts will be reviewed to maximize credit transfer. Additionally, applicants who have college-level work from a four-year college will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis to maximize credit transfer.
- **Technical Diploma Credit:** Associate degree nursing graduates who began in technical diploma level programs as their pathway to completing their Associate of Applied Science Degree in Nursing (ADN) will have their credits recognized in the same manner as the Associate of Applied Science – Nursing program.
- **Graduation Credits:** A total of 120 credits (semester hours) are needed to confer the BSN degree at Lakeland University. Also, a minimum of 30 credits (semester hours) of college credit must be earned through Lakeland University.
- **Publication of Agreement:** Each institution may market this agreement.
- **Continuation of Agreement:** This agreement will take effect upon the signing of the parties and shall continue until both parties agree in writing to modify or terminate the agreement.

***Interdisciplinary Studies requirements**

- **GEN 112 – Composition II: Argumentation and Research**
- **Core II: Exploring the Human Condition** (select one 3 semester hour course)
- **Core III: Shaping the Future** (select one 3 semester hour course)

***Area of Emphasis requirements:** completion of **one** of the following areas of emphasis designed for the nursing major. May be partially or fully satisfied with transfer credit.

Student Designed: Students may propose a twelve (12) semester-hour (minimum) emphasis in an area of academic interest that complements their major. Students may fulfill the emphasis requirement by completing current courses offered by Lakeland University that are relevant to the area of interest. This emphasis plan must be approved in advance by the student's academic advisor and the Director of the Nursing Program. Up to six (6) semester hours of Experiential Learning may be used to partially fulfill the Student Designed emphasis. Cooperative Education courses may not be used to satisfy the requirement of this emphasis.

Healthcare Business Management: recommended for the nurse who aspires to contribute to the health care business organization, desires to be an entrepreneur or who wishes to pursue their master's degree with a Nurse Administrator/Clinical Nurse Leader focus. Minimum of four courses.

System Leadership and Management: recommended for the nurse who is innovative and seeks to provoke change through effective engagement of leadership and management principles. Recommended for the student who wishes to pursue a leadership role or their master's degree with a Nurse Administrator/Clinical Nurse Leader focus. Minimum of four courses.

Cultural and Diversity Studies: recommended for the nurse who wishes to increase their cultural competence and deliberate the social context of professional nursing practice. Minimum of four courses.

Behavioral and Psychiatric Health: recommended for the nurse who wishes to increase their skills in psychiatric-mental health nursing or who wishes to pursue Psychiatric Mental Health Advanced Practice Nursing (PMH-APRN). Minimum of four courses.
