 UWL Bachelor of Science in Early Childhood Education Degree (ECE)

Purpose:

This articulation agreement allows Western students in the AAS Early Childhood Education program to be awarded the following equivalent credits upon entry to UWL with declared major in Early Childhood Education.

Transfer Courses:

The Western AAS in Early Childhood Education degree will satisfy the UWL equivalencies listed in Table 1.

Special Considerations

1. A minimum grade point average of 2.75 must have been earned at Western to meet admission to SOE requirements.
2. Students must successfully complete all SOE, major, and UWL degree requirements in the UWL catalog.
3. Admission to SOE may be competitive and meeting minimum application requirements does not guarantee admission.
4. Before transferring, students and their advisors are encouraged to review the application requirements in the UWL Undergraduate Catalog. During their enrollment at Western, prospective transfer students are advised to regularly contact the UWL SOE Academic Services Director.
5. Upon admission to UWL, students will be assigned an ECE advisor from UWL.
6. This agreement is subject to review every 5 years from the effective date and if Western or UWL undergoes curriculum revision.
7. This agreement shall be effective on January 23, 2024, and shall automatically renew on every January 23, for an additional year, unless terminated with a two-year written notice.
