**PROGRAM AGREEMENT BETWEEN
UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-STOUT
AND
COLLEGES OF THE WISCONSIN TECHNICAL COLLEGE SYSTEM**

This Agreement is entered into between participating **Colleges of the Wisconsin Technical College System** (hereinafter sending institution), and the **University of Wisconsin-Stout, Menomonie, WI** (hereinafter receiving institution or UW-Stout).

The sending institutions have established a **Criminal Justice Law Enforcement 720 Academy program** (hereinafter sending program), and the receiving institution has established a **B.S. Criminal Justice Rehabilitation** (hereinafter receiving program) and will facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition from one related program to another. It is mutually agreed:

I. Admission and Graduation Requirements

- A. The sending institution agrees to admit current UW-Stout Criminal Justice Rehabilitation students after completion of a minimum of 60 credits in their program.
- B. The receiving institution's admission and program admission requirements apply to both direct entry students and to students who transfer under this agreement.
- C. Students must fulfill the grade requirements at both institutions for the credits to apply to the UW-Stout program.
- D. Students at UW-Stout will be required to complete a minimum of 32 credits in residence for a bachelor's degree at UW-Stout.
- E. Students must complete the entire sending program for the agreement to apply.

II. Transfer of Credits

- A. The receiving institution will apply 20 of the 21-23 credits from the sending program. A total of 100 credits remain to complete the receiving program.
- B. Students may complete the 40 General Education courses at a WTCS institution in addition to the Law Enforcement Academy, leaving 60 credits remaining to complete the receiving program.
- C. Courses will transfer as described in the attached Program Articulation Table.
- D. Elective courses taken or substituted at the sending institution and sending program not listed in this agreement will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and determined how they may apply to the degree at the receiving institution.

III. Implementation and Review

- A. The Provost, Dean, Program Director, or designees of the parties to this agreement will implement the terms of this agreement, including identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements, assuring compliance with system policy, procedure, and guidelines, and conducting a periodic review of this agreement.
- B. This updated Program Agreement is effective on 03/01/2024 and shall remain in effect until the end date of 03/01/2029 or for five years, whichever occurs first, unless terminated or amended by either party with 90 days prior written notice.
- C. The college and university shall work with students to resolve the transfer of courses should changes to either program occur while the agreement is in effect.
- D. This Program Agreement will be reviewed by both parties beginning 09/01/2028 (within six months of the end date).
- E. When a student enrolls at the receiving institution following this agreement, the receiving institution will encode any course waivers and substitutions.
- F. This Program Agreement applies only to the receiving program in effect Fall 2024 until revised.


