



Western Technical College and Viterbo University Co-Admission

Co-Admission is an admissions process that allows students to be formally admitted to both Western Technical College and Viterbo University. The purpose of co-admission is to increase the ease of a successful transfer and transition from Western Technical College to Viterbo University.

Western Technical College co-admitted students will enjoy the following benefits and privileges:

- Work with a Viterbo University representative on the Western campus: Taylor Hanson, Western Transfer Specialist
- Lock into a Viterbo University academic catalog to ensure all planned Western courses will directly transfer
- Exclusive Western student visit experiences to Viterbo University
- Exclusive Western co-admission student pre-orientation and orientation experiences
- Joint Western-Viterbo first-year experience programming
- Viterbo University student ID
- Access to the Academic Resource Center, including tutoring services
- Access to the Library, including databases
- Opportunity to join Viterbo University or joint student clubs and organizations
- Access to the Mathy Center at Viterbo University
- Entry to Viterbo University athletic events
- Access to the Viterbo University Cafeteria
- Opportunity to apply for resident housing at Viterbo University, as capacity and policy allows
- Reduced-price student tickets to Fine Arts Center events
- Invitation to Ethics Institute and business school events, such as Leadership at Noon
- \$10,000 renewable scholarship when enrolled at Viterbo University, not to be stacked with other articulation or merit scholarships

Longevity of agreement and conditions for change:

This agreement shall remain in force until terminated by either party, with or without cause, upon 60 days written notice to the other party. Upon termination of this agreement, students previously admitted to Viterbo University pursuant to this agreement shall continue to receive the benefits identified by this agreement and the applicable Viterbo University catalog for a period not to exceed four (4) years. Proposed changes in policies or curricula by either party will be communicated annually.

Effective date:

This agreement is effective on December 4, 2019 and takes effect for students being admitted to Viterbo University for fall 2020.
