Community-Based Learning (CBL) is required experiential learning where students take what they are learning in the classroom & apply those skills to projects or volunteer needs within the community. We recommend highlighting relevant volunteer activities and projects on your resume. This is especially helpful if you are a recent graduate or changing careers.

 Highlight information that is detailed and specific to you.

Match your volunteering skills to the job description.

- □ Identify the type of project and/or activity.
- □ Share results and/or achievements.
- \Box Help quantify the work by using numbers.
- Feature essential and technical skills.
